

MISSION OFFER – INCARNATION OF THE AVATAR “CARMEN ORTIZ” – EL4DEV metaverse

Project: Live-Action Role-Playing Game in an Alternate Reality – Universe of Paul Elvere DELSART

Symbolic and Referential Location: Town Hall of Torreblanca (Castellón, Spain)

Format: Artistic and philosophical participation – A living role with community impact

Duration: Open-ended – depending on motivation, commitment, and shared vision

Compensation: Non-financial. Symbolic, creative, community-based and ethical reward.

WHO IS “CARMEN ORTIZ”?

“Carmen ORTIZ” is a fictional and symbolic avatar representing ethical leadership, innovative local governance, and a model of territorial transformation within the speculative fiction multiverse created by Paul Elvere DELSART.

She embodies the idealized mayor of an alternative Torreblanca: resilient, cooperative, eco-conscious, and at the forefront of social and technological innovation. Her role weaves a creative link between existing reality and utopian possibilities.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

A person ready to embody Carmen ORTIZ with imagination, civic engagement, critical thinking, and openness to social experimentation.

No prior political experience is required, but the following qualities are expected:

- Ability in artistic, narrative, or theatrical expression.
- Genuine interest in ethical, social, and ecological issues.
- Desire to play intelligently with the boundaries between fiction and reality.
- Sensitivity to the territory of Torreblanca and its cultural context.

Previous experience as a mayor of a small municipality in the province of Castellón is a highly valued asset for this position.

YOUR MISSIONS AS THE AVATAR “CARMEN ORTIZ”

- Participate in performative or symbolic actions in public or digital spaces.
- Represent the ideals of the “Torreblanca of the Future” in events, texts, and dialogues.
- Correspond (fictionally but credibly) with other avatars of the EL4DEV universe.
- Inspire through your posture: leading through responsible utopia.

Send a creative motivation letter (text, video, or audio) in which you explain:

- Why you wish to embody the young, dynamic, and courageous mayor of Torreblanca, Carmen ORTIZ.
- What symbolic first action you would initiate in this role.
- Your vision for an ethical, innovative, and united Torreblanca.

Psychological portrait of Carmen ORTIZ

Deep Identity

Carmen ORTIZ is an archetype of awakened civic consciousness. She is not merely a woman, nor even a fictional political figure: she embodies a living principle of ethical and poetic governance.

In the universe of Paul Elvere DELSART, she acts as a mediator between the utopian ideal and the complexity of reality; a bridge between the collective dream and concrete responsibility.

Dominant Traits

Ethics and moral integrity:

Carmen lives according to an ethic of coherence; one that aligns word, intention, and action. She feels even the slightest dissonance between conviction and behavior as an inner wound, which drives her to constant vigilance over her own motivations.

Active empathy:

Her emotional intelligence is highly developed. She does not merely understand the emotions of others; she knows how to transform them into a driving force for social connection. She perceives what is unspoken, the collective vulnerabilities, and transmutes them into restorative initiatives.

Visionary and pragmatic at once:

Carmen navigates between two poles: lucid dreaming and constructive realism. She conceives projects that may appear utopian but makes them possible by grounding them in symbolic and community-based actions.

Quiet strength:

Behind her calm and benevolence lies an unshakable will. She does not assert herself through hierarchical authority but through inner coherence and the clarity of her gaze. Her power comes from meaning, not from status.

Inner psychodynamics

Carmen is traversed by a creative conflict: the desire to change the world without falling into dogmatism. At times, she struggles with the vertigo of the ideal: the fear of being consumed by the symbolism of her role and losing her human spontaneity.

Her spirituality is not mystical but relational: she believes in the redemption of the world through cooperation, listening, and the poetry of the just gesture.

Her collective unconscious carries the memory of a wounded land: Torreblanca as a metaphor for the rural world: marginalized yet bearing the seeds of renewal. In her dreams, she often speaks with symbolic figures (children, trees, seas and ancestors) who remind her that power is nothing more than a service rendered to life.

Symbolic Role in the EL4DEV Multiverse

In DELSART's speculative mythology, Carmen ORTIZ embodies the mayor of the utopian city; a figure of sensitive governance that transcends the divides between nature, technology, and spirituality.

She represents:

- The feminine ethic of power (listening, care, intuition, inclusion)
- Embodied democracy, where politics becomes a living art
- Transformation through play, where reality becomes poetic to reveal new ways of inhabiting the world
